

Save Now with ebill

Invoicing is a key process in your business and needs to be as cost-effective as possible. No matter the size of your company, eBill is the most cost-effective invoicing method.

The following model calculation shows the savings potential of eBill. Based on the costs of a paper invoice (100%), the total costs of an eBill are only 42% in comparison. By switching to eBill, total costs of 58% can thus be saved. Even compared to sending invoices by e-mail, the total costs are practically halved. Switching to eBill is not only worthwhile financially: You and your customers also benefit from the high security standards offered by the Swiss financial center.


