The following model calculation shows the savings potential of eBill. Compared to paper invoices (65%), as well as compared to sending invoices by e-mail (37%), a significant cost reduction can be realized. Switching to eBill is not only worthwhile financially: You and your customers also benefit from the high security standards offered by the Swiss financial center.

Switching to eBill Is Worthwhile for You and Your Customers


