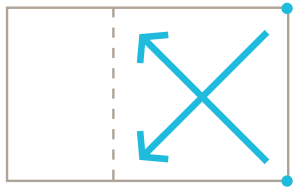




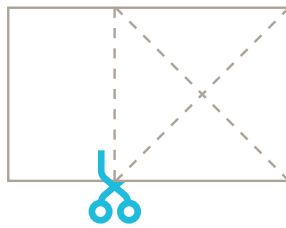
Time for origami.



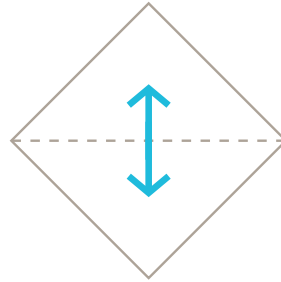

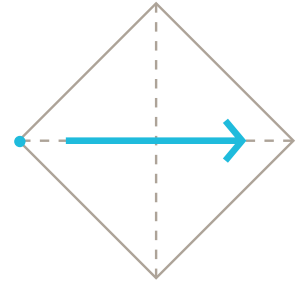
1. Fold the upper or lower right corner to make a square.



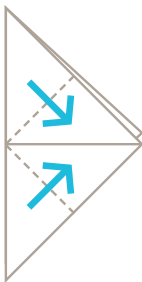
2. Cut off the excess part.



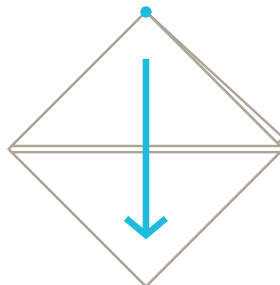
3. Fold the paper horizontally in the middle and back out again.



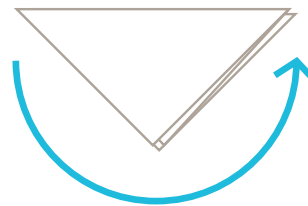
4. Fold the paper vertically in the middle.



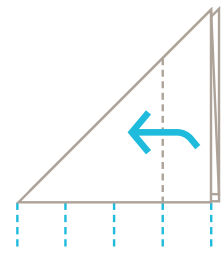
5. Fold both the upper and lower left corners to the right edge of the triangle.



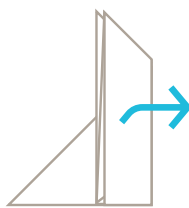
6. Fold the upper corner onto the lower corner.



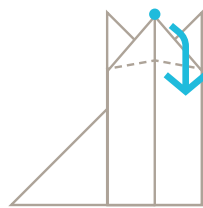
7. Turn the paper by 90 degrees to the right.



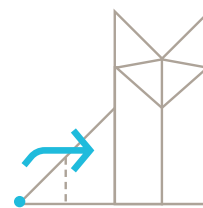
8. Divide the paper into 4 identical sections and fold the outermost part on the right to the middle.



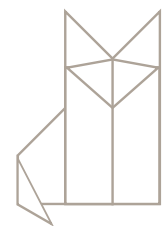
9. Fold one half back out again.



10. Fold the upper middle corner down.



11. Fold the outermost corner on the left to the middle and leave it a bit open.



12. Done is your fox!
